About the role

- Installation, removal, maintenance, testing and repair of street lighting columns and other electrified street furniture including the excavation for columns, signposts, bollards etc.
- Excavation of shallow trenches, laying cable and ducting in preparation for electrification of equipment, backfill and temporary reinstatement of surfaces.
- Driving of vehicles and the safe operation of specialist vehicles (e.g. crane, wagons, HIAB).
- To be able to safely operate small plant, compressors, plate compactors etc.
- To undertake such additional duties as are reasonably commensurate with the level of the post.
- The post holder will carry out their duties with full regard to the City Council's Equal Opportunities Health & Safety and Community Strategy policies.
- If required, to participate in the efficient operation of the street lighting Out of Hours emergency service.
- Compliance with working instruction response times, ensuring whenever possible the completion of 2-hour, 24 hour and 28 day response work orders.
- To be responsible for your own Safety at Work and work in line with current safe working methods, Codes of Practice and Risk Assessments.
- To be competent of driving vehicles and to safely operate associated tools, plant and equipment to an industry recognised standard.
- The completion of necessary paperwork including timesheets, daily work records, vehicle check sheets and electrical certification etc.
- To comply fully with the Chapter 8 safety management guidelines and procedures.
- Basic setting out of works and interpretation of plans and information given.
- Working with the public whilst on official duties.
- Act as cover for the Street Lighting Supervisor during absence.
- To undertake such additional duties as are reasonably commensurate with the level of the post.
