Main duties and responsibilities/accountabilities

To undertake such additional duties as are reasonably commensurate with the level of this post.

**Classroom Teacher**

- Ensure a high quality and well organised learning environment in the classroom and communal areas.
- Ensure teaching and learning is at least 'good' by regular triangulation of evidence including books (including marking), teaching and the learning environment.
- Ensure that planning (both short and medium term) meets school guidelines.
- Ensure curriculum content including desired knowledge and expectations are communicated to parents in advance with details of any trip and/or visit and website areas updated accordingly.
- Ensure standards of children's work and presentation meet the schools basic skills, handwriting and marking policies, are 'good' or better. Primary focus on English and maths but maintain presentation and marking standards across all subjects.
- Ensure that the school assessment timetable, tracking information, pupil progress grids and Assessment Pupil Progress are updated termly and reported at Phase meetings.
- In partnership with the Senior Leadership Team, ensure that intervention/support work planned meets the needs of the children. Learning Support
- Assistants to be aware of current and projected targets for pupils and are deployed effectively throughout the Phase.
- Contribute to continued professional development by being an excellent role model in teaching and learning including behaviour and classroom management.
- Work together as a team in your phase to promote the aims of the school
- Ensure the ethos and behaviour in your classroom, common areas and playground include break times and lunchtimes, is commensurate with school policies and guidelines and that the protocol of positive behaviour management is adhered to
- Follow guidelines for timetables and rotas (as directed by the Head of School) and be prompt in your duties and responsibilities for supervision.
- Respond to immediate pastoral and health and safety matters in class and liaise with staff with key responsibilities on these issues.
- Report and monitor as necessary, any organisation and management issues.

- Seek opportunities to improve parental engagement with their children's learning.
- Seek opportunities to improve governor engagement with teaching and learning.

#### **Standards and quality assurance**

- Contribute to the development of a positive inclusive ethos.
- Set a good example in terms of dress, punctuality and attendance.
- Attend and participate in open evenings and pupil performances.
- Uphold the school's behaviour code and uniform regulations
- Participate in staff training.
- Attend team and staff meetings.
- Develop links with governors, LA and neighbouring schools.
