Main Purpose of the Job

We are seeking to appoint an Engineer with experience in street lighting maintenance who can also work with a GIS system to deliver projects. The post holder will record site activities, oversee contractors work, provide solutions for day to day issues and assist with the delivery of reactive, routine and planned maintenance service.

Key Responsibilities

- Produce plans and reports.
- Support lighting design work.
- Maintain street lighting asset inventory records.
- Assist in researching, analysing and interpreting a range of data including asset information held in GIS to aid compliance with the Council's policies, plans & procedures.
- Assist with the preparation of annual programmes of lighting work in collaboration with other teams.
- Work with Contractors and Utility companies.
- Arrange recharges with our recovery team.
- Ensure lighting or electrical assets on the highway are working correctly and arrange repair work when needed.
- Ensure timely completion of reactive and routine maintenance activities.
- Deliver of lighting related projects.
