



Job Description – Playworker

Main purpose of the job:

To be responsible to the After-School Club Manager under the overall authority of the headteacher, for the supervision of pupils during after school club.

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

KEY AREAS

Supervision of children during after school club activities

Ensuring that hygiene standards are maintained

Ensuring that safety standards are maintained

Ensuring that school behaviour policies and guidelines are followed

Job Activities:

Supervision of Children

To ensure that after-school club is a safe environment for children, staff and others, that equipment is safe, standards of hygiene are high, safety procedures are implemented

Responsibility for the provision of creative and appropriate play opportunities which meet the needs of children with differing abilities.

To actively support the children's social development, through appropriate activities and to provide support for other staff in these activities if required.

Ensure that all children are treated as individuals regardless of race, culture, gender or disability.

Ensure the safety and accountability of all children at all times.

To prepare and deliver healthy food to the children in a safe and hygienic environment.

To maintain a good and informative rapport with parents.

Co-ordinate and help set up and clear away all equipment/activities before and after all after school club sessions.

To be responsible for ensuring that the building/equipment/material and kept tidy and in good working order.

To ensure the health & safety requirements within the play environment are met at all times.

Be aware of the importance of confidentiality with regard to information which you may have access to concerning children/staff/parent/carers.

To administer first aid as appropriate.

To attend training as required.

Set a positive role model for children.

Any other duties deemed necessary for the safe and efficient running of the club.

To provide refreshments and be aware of food safety hygiene regulations.
