Our employees are our **greatest asset**. We're proud of the way we provide vital frontline services every day and work together, as **one team**.

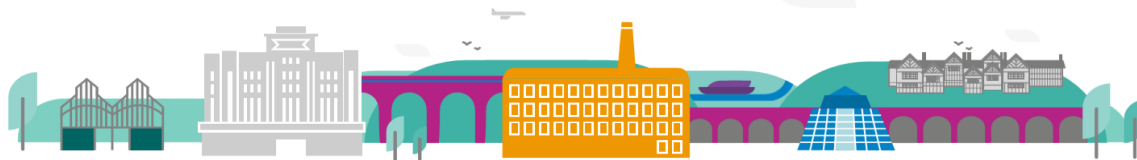
Our 4 **core values** as shown above, run through everything that we do, and we aim to stay **true** to them regardless of the challenges that we may face.

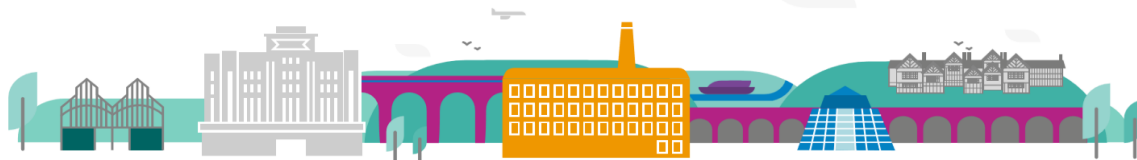

### Main Purpose of the Job

- To contribute to improving the safety and performance of the public highway network through the pro-active management of all modes of traffic and any works taking place upon the public highway.
- To provide high quality, cost effective services. To manage and deliver services and/or projects, taking a holistic, joined up view of service and/or project design, delivery and evaluation.
- To ensure that the Council manages its resources effectively, delivering value for money, enhancing opportunities to improve efficiencies and generating revenue where appropriate.
- To apply skills, knowledge and experience to provide the Council with authoritative technical advice on improving and maintaining the performance of the public highway network through the pro-active management of all modes of traffic and the application of innovative design and maintenance regimes.

### Key Responsibilities

- Contribute to the key aims and objectives of the Organisation, both within the post holder's specific remit, across Sustainable Transport & Highways Service, Place Directorate and the Council as a whole.
- Develop a shared understanding and knowledge of your own and other Sustainable Transport & Highways Service areas.
- Prepare, develop, deliver, manage and monitor projects and programmes that are aligned with the purpose of the Sustainable Transport & Highways Service.
- Identify hazards, review risk assessments, contribute to pre-construction information and ensure all design and construction works for schemes are planned and completed in accordance with relevant legislation.
- To be responsible for developing and maintaining effective internal and external stakeholder relationships including Councillors, the public, consultants, contractors and private developers.



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- To work positively and inclusively with colleagues and customers so that the Council provides a workplace to deliver a service that does not discriminate against people on the grounds of their age, disability, gender reassignment, marriage, civil partnership, pregnancy, maternity, race, religion, belief, sex, or sexual orientation.

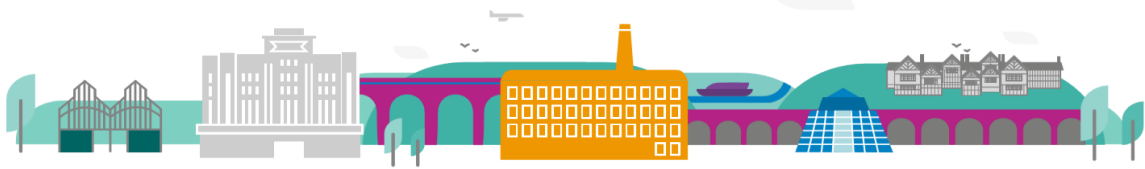
