The post hours are:

Our Teaching Assistants generally support one class, usually for a year or more, however, they can be asked to support **any class or child throughout the school at any time**. Please also note that our Teaching Assistants support lunchtimes as well. This enables us to maintain the consistently good behaviour and attitude of our pupils throughout the school day.

We are a successful school with good standards achieved against a backdrop of significant urban agendas. Our staff team work hard to attain our school's achievements and we are very proud of our children. We currently have 225 children on roll and we operate as a one-form entry school with a nursery.
