Your job will be based within the resident Services team and will be working with other highway maintenance operatives.

Supervising lighting operatives you will look to deliver a range of activities within the street lighting operational maintenance program along with wider activities throughout the council's services.

You will attend emergency call outs, according to the Standby rota, both during and outside working hours which includes weekend and public holidays.

You will complete maintenance work to contract specification both during working hours and outside working hours ensuring full compliance with Health and safety regulations.

You will ensure quality services are delivered, fairly, courteously and responsively to our customers both internal and external.

On an ongoing basis you will:

- Ensure Health & Safety Regulations are followed at all times, referring to advice from the Health & Safety wellbeing team as necessary, addressing all breaches.
- Ensure you operate within GDPR guidelines by regularly reviewing data held and destroying information in line with retention schedules
