You will hold specific areas of operational responsibility, agreed with the Lakes Team Manager, that directly support the achievement of departmental objectives. You will provide day to day leadership to staff, uphold Be Well values, and play a key role in creating a positive, safe and inclusive environment for colleagues and customers.

In the next 12 months, you will:

- Support the Lakes Team Manager in reviewing and strengthening operational systems, procedures and safeguards to ensure safe and efficient delivery.
- Contribute to refreshing the seasonal programme offer, helping to introduce new activities or improve existing ones.

- Assist with developing a staff training and competency plan, ensuring qualifications and skills are up to date.
- Help review residential operations (accommodation, catering, housekeeping) to identify improvements in quality and customer experience.
- Support the expansion of partnerships with schools and community groups to increase engagement and bookings.
- Contribute to improvements in performance reporting, helping develop clearer dashboards, insights and evaluation methods.

On an ongoing basis you will:

- Support the safe and high quality delivery of all outdoor adventure and residential programmes at the Lakes site for schools, groups and residents.
- Assist with compliance, site safety, equipment inspections, maintenance schedules and statutory checks, ensuring accurate record keeping.
- Support the management of residential operations including welcome, accommodation, catering, housekeeping and guest care to ensure consistently excellent customer experiences.
- Embed Be Well values and the Council's missions into programme delivery, with a focus on inclusion and reducing inequalities.
- Contribute to annual programme planning and the seasonal timetable for land and water based activities.
- Support the development of staff capability through training, coaching, mentoring and accreditation processes.
- Strengthen partnerships with schools, community organisations and sector bodies to enhance and extend the service offer.
- Contribute to performance management, producing data, reports, case studies and insights to support continuous improvement.
- Provide visible day to day leadership, modelling Be Well behaviours and promoting a culture of safety, care and continuous improvement.
- Support safeguarding, risk management and health & safety processes, ensuring robust operating procedures, incident reporting and learning reviews are in place.
- Maintain effective customer service systems, responding to feedback and resolving escalated issues promptly and empathetically.
- Work with the Be Well Outdoors management team to promote programmes and optimise customer journeys from enquiry to evaluation.

- Maintain positive relationships with partners, landowners, regulators, National Park bodies and community stakeholders.
- Deputise for the Team Manager when required, representing the service in networks and forums and sharing good practice.

- Understanding of inclusion, customer care and equal opportunities, with a commitment to removing barriers to participation.
- A full UK driving licence and the ability to travel between sites as required.
- Experience of delivering and developing outdoor adventure programmes for schools, groups and residents, including residential provision.
- Personal delivery experience across land and/or water based activities, with a strong understanding of risk management in outdoor environments.

- Operational management experience in a multi activity or residential outdoor centre, including people supervision and rota/resource planning.
- Experience drafting and implementing risk assessments, operating procedures and session plans.
- Experience delivering activities such as bushcraft, problem solving, raft building, archery and rafted canoeing.
