Job Title: Assistant Streetscene Operative

As an Assistant Streetscene Operative you will work as part of a Team to support the effective delivery of day to day Streetscene maintenance operations.

You will carry out a range of Streetscene duties to maintain a clean, safe and green environment throughout the borough.

In supporting the service, you will actively seek ways of improvement, and support with suggestions for new ways of working and embracing change.

On an on-going basis you will:

- Provide a multi skilled Street cleaning resource including the inspection of play areas, sharps and dead animals, litter picking and fly tipping removal.

- Undertake the full range of Streetscene maintenance tasks including emptying street bins, litter picking, grass cutting, pruning of shrub beds & hedge cutting.
- Assist with the delivery of planned clean up events and waste amnesties in partnership with other agencies.
- Maintain relevant operational records and documentation and submit them in a timely manner.
- Support policies, procedures, relevant legislation and good practice, particularly regarding Health and Safety, ensuring the required quality standards are achieved.
- Assist with resolving day to day problems.
- Effectively operate the full range of grass cutting equipment & powered hand tools utilised to maintain the Streetscene.
- Be accountable for all vehicles and equipment issued and used, complete safety inspections as required and operating them in line with Council policies, procedures or work instructions.
- Embrace Progress with Unity; act as 'Eyes and Ears' ambassador for the Council, reporting any issues or concerns promptly.
- If required/where appropriate undertake driving duties, such as transporting staff, machinery, and materials, safely.
- Provide an 'eyes and ears' service across the borough by reporting any problems you observe, such as blocked gullies, fly tipping or anti-social behaviour through the relevant reporting procedure.

Ensure you operate within GDPR guidelines by regularly reviewing data held and destroying information in line with retention schedules
