1.1.1 Within the above statutory conditions, you are required to carry out the following responsibilities in consultation with the Headteacher

SECTION TWO : CURRICULUM

- 2.1 To help develop and maintain a curriculum in line with the National Curriculum to meet the needs of individual children within your class, taking account of the wide range of ability.
- 2.2 To work with other members of staff to ensure that the extremes of the ability range are catered for.
- 2.3 To monitor and evaluate the curriculum offered and assist in maintaining and reviewing appropriate planning, assessment, record keeping and reporting procedures, as and when appropriate.
- 2.4 To ensure efficient use and maintenance of all material teaching resources within your classroom area and working environment and to see that available resources are used efficiently to support the curriculum.
- 2.5 To maintain good practice and implement changes in accordance with development in educational theory and practice.
- 2.6 To maintain a good working environment within your classroom having particular emphasis on such aspects as organisation, lay-out, timing of sessions, activities and other ethos of the school.

SECTION THREE : PASTORAL CARE

- 3.1 To implement the school behaviour policy and procedures.
- 3.2 To ensure the school rules and Christian values are implemented throughout daily school life.
- 3.3 To create conditions for learning having due regard for the health and safety of pupils and others.
